



Introduction -


10 Key Themes of Revelation 11

- 5. Resurrection (vs.11-12)




10 Key Themes of Revelation 11

Summary Theme #2 – Expectations

- 1) God will never lose control.
- 2) God will always have a witness.
- 3) Our <u>message</u> and <u>values</u> will not be <u>celebrated</u> by our <u>surrounding culture</u>. Rather, our <u>destruction</u> will be <u>celebrated</u> by our surrounding culture.
- 4) God will judge the wicked.



Summary Theme #2 – Expectations

- 5) God will **reward** His **servants**.
- 6) Jesus, the Messiah, will return and reign forever.
- 7) God will <u>save</u> <u>some</u>.
