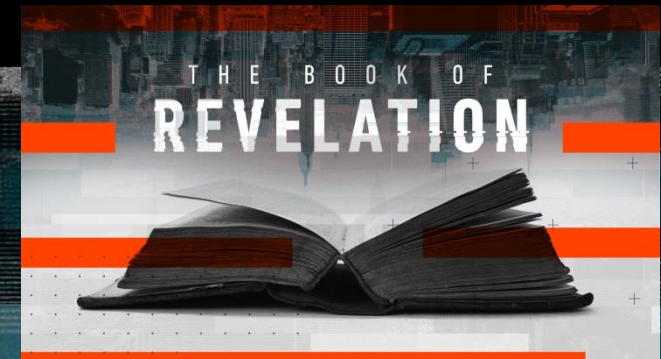

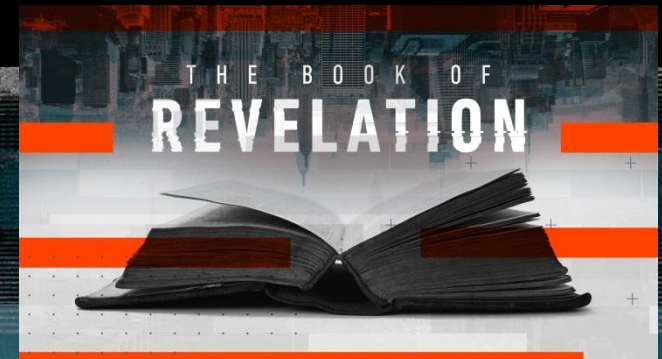
Introduction -

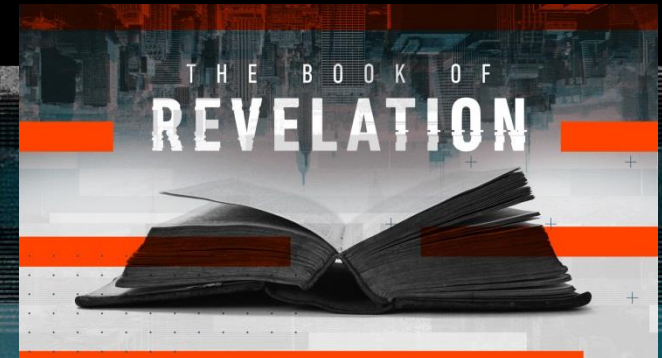
*Key Battle Lesson – Satan

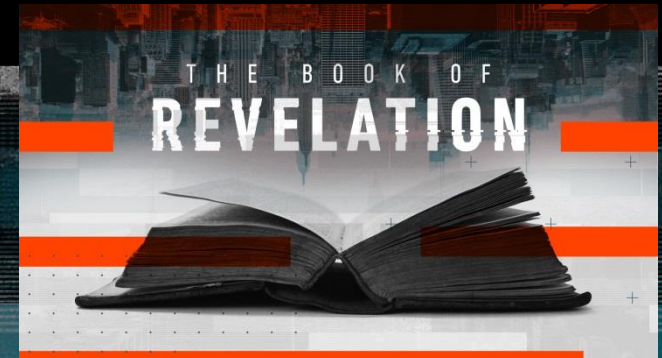
- Michael (and his angels)

The Battle Summary

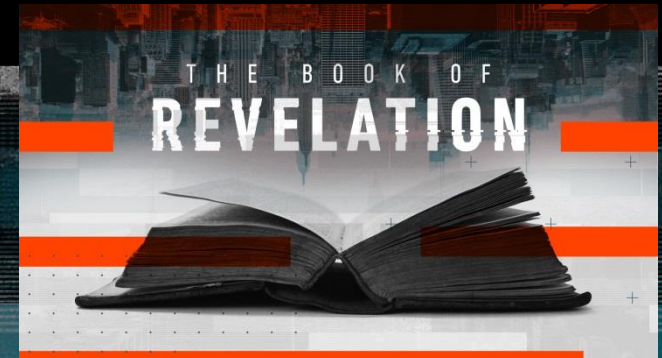
- *And they were not strong enough . . . (vs.8)*

The Battle Lessons

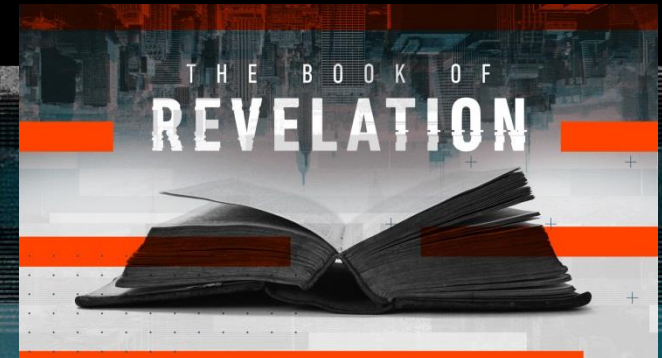
1. God will put an end to Satan's evil pleasure of accusation.

 - Persisting in obedience and witness in the face of possible martyrdom.

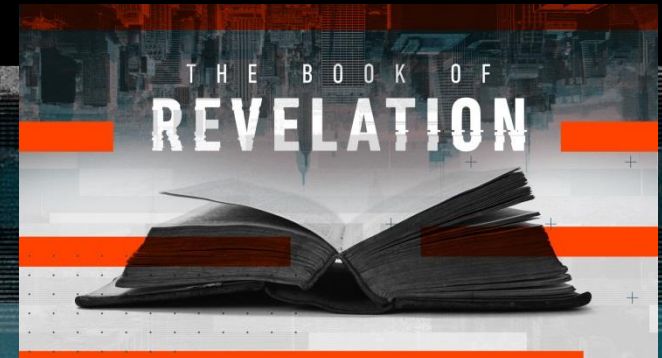

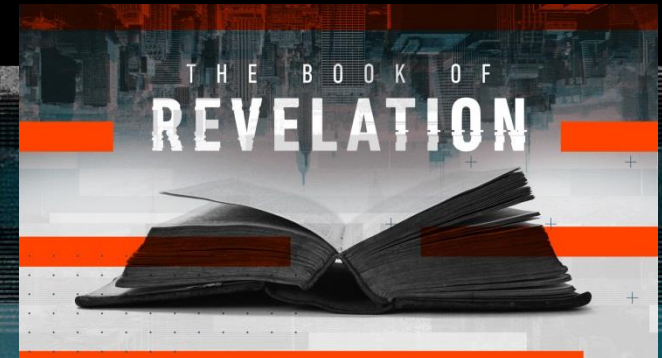
